

Incident Management Team Training

Purpose

To develop a group of candidates from the same organisation to perform effectively as an Incident Management Team (IMT).

Who should attend?

This course is suitable for personnel nominated to roles on an IMT and is applicable to any organisation that operates high-hazard sites. Typically, candidates for this course will be from core roles in the same organisation, including operations, logistics, communications and HR. In their functional role, they will support the organisation's operational response and manage wider, longer-term impacts to the organisation, including stakeholder relations and business interruption.

Method

Before scheduling your training, we work with you to identify current levels of competence, so we can identify development objectives for the team. We increase the experiential element progressively so that, by the second day, candidates are developing their skills through experiential learning in simulations. We create the space for delegates to experiment in a safe environment and reflect on results.

Why work with us?

We believe in an evidence-based approach, using competencies extracted from The Regulations and Guidance. Duration 2 days (days may be consecutive or separated)

Course content

- Emergency management principles
- Emergency management structure and process
- Roles and responsibilities on the IMT
- IMT leadership and facilitation
- Situational awareness and decision-making process
- Liaison with the emergency services
- Information management and reporting
- Stakeholder management and communications
