1. Course timings

Courses start at 09:00 and conclude before 17:00.

5. Getting here - Travel

	Manchester International is our closest airport, approximately 1 hour from Hathersage by road or rail.
	Hathersage can be reached by rail from either Manchester or Sheffield, with trains operating hourly. We are 2 minutes' walk from the rail station.
	By road. Once in Hathersage, follow the signs for the train station. Our facility is located 100m beyond the train station. There is parking on the road opposite and in the station car park. Please be considerate to other users, spaces outside offices are reserved, some of the Eddystone slots may be available. You may be asked to move your car if it blocks other office tenants
